GPRO is a comprehensive national training and certificate program that teaches the people who build, renovate and maintain buildings the principles of sustainability combined with trade-specific green construction knowledge.

All GPRO courses are taught by certified GPRO Instructors, who are experienced professionals in the construction industry and are well-informed about sustainability issues.

### **Required qualifications for GPRO Instructor Applicants:**

- ✓ A recommendation from a GPRO Delivery Partner. A list of Delivery Partners can be found at <http://gpro.org/deliverypartners>.
- ✓ At least 5 years of professional experience in the field of the trade-specific module you intend to teach.
- ✓ A passion for sustainability, knowledge of green building practices and a willingness to further your knowledge in your field.

### **Suggested qualifications for GPRO Instructor Applicants:**

- Experience as a trainer in your respective organization.
- Training in adult education.

To apply, please fill out the GPRO Instructor Application, available for download at <http://gpro.org/instructors>.

If your application is approved, you will be required to participate in a GPRO Instructor Training session (for non-certificate holders), or you will be asked to verify your GPRO certification and attend a GPRO Instructor Orientation.

Urban Green Council reviews instructors on an ongoing basis. While teaching, instructors will be expected to maintain a consistent level of student engagement and performance.
